DAY 1: TUXTLA GUTIERREZ AIRPORT – TOUR TO THE SUMIDERO CANYON AND MAGICAL TOWN OF CHIAPA DE CORZO – SAN CRISTÓBAL DE LAS CASAS

Later we will transfer you to the hotel in San Cristóbal de las Casas to register and rest arriving at 6:00 p.m. approximately. **Lodging in San Cristobal de las Casas**

4:30 p.m. We will continue on our way to reach the Misol Ha Waterfall, a beautiful 30-meter-high waterfall that has a path that will take you behind the curtain of water and have a unique view of the place. We will arrive in the city of Palenque at approximately 6:00 p.m. Lodging in Palenque.

DAY 4: TOUR TO THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL ZONE OF PALENQUE - CAMPECHE

Breakfast at the hotel. 9:00 am. Departure to visit the archaeological zone of Palenque, one of the most important cities of the Mayan Culture. You will be able to visit the Temple of the Inscriptions, the Skull, the Red Queen, the Crosses and the Main Palace. As well as visiting the baths of the Queen (natural waterfall



within the archaeological zone). All this surrounded by a jungle landscape that will captivate you. **12:00 pm.** We begin a 5-hour transfer to the City of Campeche. Note: You will have time for lunch en route. DAY 6: TOUR TO HACIENDA SOTUTA DE PEÓN - CENOTE - MÉRIDA

Breakfast at the hotel. 8:15 a.m. We will go to see the Sotuta de Peón Hacienda, where we will make an interesting 2- hour journey into the past while we enjoy the most important points of the Hacienda.

When touring the Hacienda, you will feel transported back in time, since you will go aboard wooden platforms on rails called "Trucks" which are pulled by mules, just as the workers used at that time. Here, you will be able to witness the transformation process of Henequen (also called Green Gold in this region), from the plant to the fiber, and from the fiber to the finished product, in addition to being able to visit a typical Mayan house and you will also be able to refresh themselves in the Hacienda's best kept secret: the Cenote. You can swim in some beautiful pools with crystalline and refreshing waters, or if you prefer you can also swim in the pool of the Hacienda that is surrounded by spectacular vegetation. At the end of the tour there will be time to taste some typical appetizers of the region (included in price) and if you like you can order main course food dishes (not included). Later we will ransfer you back to the hotel in Merida.

DAY 7: TOUR TO THE RÍA CELESTÚN BIOSPHERE RESERVE - MÉRIDA

8:00 am. Transfer of almost 2 hours to the Ría Celestún Biosphere Reserve, it is one of the reserves with the greatest richness of species and interdependent ecosystems, namely, mangroves, dunes, petenes, low jungle and grasslands. One of the main attractions of the reserve is bird watching since Ría Celestún is one of the main resting, feeding and reproduction sites for a wide variety of birds, including colonies of beautiful pink flamingos. surprise yourself! The tour includes a boat ride lasting just under 2 hours through the estuary, the mangroves and bird island, as well as time to cool off in a spring with crystal clear waters. Tip: Flamingos are nervous birds, so we ask you not to scare them or make them fly. It is recommended to enjoy them in silence and do not forget to have your camera or video camera ready. The season in which more flamingos are sighted is from November to April. Finishing the tour at 12:00 p.m. Approximately you will have time for lunch to taste seafood taken from the sea by fishermen from the same town, in a restaurant facing the sea. Travel Tips: Bring a swimsuit and personal towel in case you want to swim.

3:00 pm. Transfer back to the hotel in Mérida arriving at 5:00 p.m. approximately. Free dinner. Lodging in Merida.

DAY 8: VISIT TO THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL ZONE OF CHICHEN ITZÁ – CENOTE IKKIL – TRANSFER TO CANCUN

Maya Route

DAY 1: WELCOME IN CANCUN - TOUR TO TULUM AND CENOTE - TULUM

9:00 am. Welcome at a hotel in Cancun, Playa del Carmen or Riviera Maya. 2-hour transfer to the magnificent archaeological zone of Tulum. Tulum was one of the most significant Mayan cities of the 13th and 14th centuries, as it was an essential stopover for the Mayan trade routes. You can visit "El Castillo", the "Temple of the Descending God", the "Temple of the Frescoes" as well as enjoy a beautiful view of this pre-Hispanic city on the shores of the Caribbean Sea.

1:00 pm. Brief snack time en route (not included) and 20-minute transfer to the Cenote Dos Ojos near Tulum. It will be a refreshing 2-hour visit to appreciate the formation of the place with a short walk in its surroundings, to later enter and swim in the transparent waters passing between stalactites and calcified columns. The water is very crystal clear and refreshing. **Note:** Life jacket and visor included.

4:30 pm. Lunch time (not included) and later transfer to hotel in Tulum. Lodging in Tulum.

DAY 2: FREE MORNING IN MAHAHUAL - BACALAR MAGICAL TOWN

1:00 pm. Return to the hotel to check out and lunch time. (Not included). **4:00 p.m.** 2-hour transfer to a hotel on the outskirts of Calakmul to spend the night. Lodging in Calakmul.

DAY 4: VISIT TO THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL ZONE OF CALAKMUL - MAGICAL TOWN OF PALENQUE

6:00 am. Departure to visit the impressive archaeological zone of Calakmul, located within the Calakmul Biosphere Reserve. Travel tip: We suggest bringing a box lunch or fruit.

In addition to getting to know this important pre-Hispanic site, you will be able to enjoy nature by observing different species of exotic birds and mammals such as deer, toucans, hocopheasants, eagles, tapirs and, if the Mayan gods allow it, one of the 350 jaguars that inhabit the area. This site has 6,750 ancient structures, including the 55-meter-high Great Pyramid, a second pyramid that rises 42 meters, tombs, the ball game, and other important buildings. This ancient Mayan city played a key role in the history of the region for more than 12 centuries and is a sample of the political and spiritual development of the Maya that is worth knowing.

2:00 p.m. Transfer of 4 hours to the Magic Town of Palenque to spend the night. **Note:** You will have time for lunch en route. **Lodging in Palenque**.

DAY 5: ARCHAEOLOGICAL ZONE OF PALENQUE - WATERFALL - PALENQUE

Breakfast at the hotel included. 8:30 a.m. We left the hotel to visit one of the biggest tourist attractions in Chiapas: the archaeological zone of Palenque, one of the most important cities of the Mayan Culture. You will be able to explore and tour the Temple of the Skull, Temple of the Inscriptions, Temple of the Red Queen, Temple of the Crosses, as well as the Main Palace of Palenque. You will also have time to visit the site museum, where there is a replica of the tomb of Pakal, one of the main discoveries of this mythical city.
